

## FOR OUR CONTRIBUTORS

Use double space throughout, without any exception.

Spelling including hyphenation, should be consistent and in conformity with the recommendation of the Concise Oxford Dictionary, except in quotations, which must retain the spelling of the original.

Use single quotation marks to enclose quoted material and double quotation marks for quoted material/titles, within quotations: 'A Feminist Deconstruction of T.S. Eliot's "The Love Song of J. Alfred Prufrock"'.

If a prose quotation runs no more than four typed lines and requires no special emphasis, please put it in single quotation marks and incorporate it in the text. A longer quotation should be indented.

Number the notes serially and type them separately in double space; include references to literature within the notes.

Place the title of an unpublished dissertation in quotation marks.
