## FOR OUR CONTRIBUTERS

The papers for this bi-annual *Journal* should be submitted to The Editor, SH&SS, Indian Institute of Advanced Studies, Rashtrapati Niwas, Shimla 171005, by post or by hand or electronically.

Electronic submission is accepted in MS Word through email (proiias@rediffmail.com) and should be accompanied or followed by a hard copy. In a submission by post or by hand, a version on floppy along with a hard copy is essential.

The submitted papers should not be already published or in press or forthcoming anywhere else. After publication in this Journal, authors of papers are *free* to publish wherever they wish after obtaining the written permission of the Editor. Responsibility for any copyright violation shall solely be of the sender/author of paper, not of the Journal.

In submitting a paper, the following conventions should be followed: *Paper Manuscript:* 

The Text of paper should be preceded by a separate Title page and followed by separate References page(s). The name and affiliation of author should be mentioned only on the Title page. Any table, diagram and/or picture, to be included in the paper, should be given separately.

Paper Format (Effective from June (Summer) 2004 issue):

- o Quotation Convention:
- Longer quotation(s) should be in a separate paragraph and indented References' Convention: The Reference page(s) should contain an alphabetically arranged list of all the works cited in the Text and Notes. This alphabetical list should be prepared following the authors' last name.
  - o Full reference details of a book should be mentioned as: Maddy, Penelope (1990), *Realism in Mathematics*, Oxford: Clarendon Press. Mention the detail of an ancient work as: Praśastapāda (c.530), *Praśastapādabhāṣya* with Śridhara's *Nyāyakandalī*, ed. and tr., Durgadhara Jha Sharma (in Hindi), Varanas: Sampurnanand Sanskrit University, 1997. Mention a paper in an anthology as: Barrett, Cyril (1974), "Kinetic Art", in Richardson, Tony and Nikos Stangos, eds., *Concept of Modern Art*, Harmondsworth: Penguin, pp.211-23. In referring to a book by two or more persons, reverse the name of the first author/editor/compiler only; other names should appear as they are.
  - o Reference to papers in periodicals should be as: Ghatak, Snehlata (2000), "Stooping Down to Conquer", *Journal of Elite Culture* 18.2, pp. 89-98.

o Reference to an introduction, preface and foreword by somebody other than the author(s) should be as: Paniker, K. Ayappa, Foreword in P.K.Rajan (1989), ed., *The Growth of the Novel in India: 1950-80*, New Delhi: Abhinay, pp. ix-xii.

Notes' Convention: Footnotes should be used for elaborating on a point etc., not merely for citing a reference, which should be cryptically cited in the Text itself, as indicated below.

Pointer convention for citing references in the Text and Notes: Cite the author in the Text or Notes only cryptically/telegraphically as: Pra\u00edastapgda (c.530: 139); Barrett (1974: 20); Paniker in Rajan (1989: ix); Ghatak (2000: 90-92). Cite a classical, indexed text as: P\u00e4\u00edninini (c500BC: i.vii.24). Indicate precisely and unambiguously the citation-specifier after the colon. The References at the end of the Text should contain the complete and unambiguous publication details of these authors and their work, as indicated in the References' Convention, above.

Table, Diagram, Picture convention: Tables should have maximum width of 5.5". All diagrams and pictures should be in high resolution.

## Diacritics:

Diacritical marks should be used while writing words of classical languages in Roman script and should be clearly marked on the hard copy. The following (Harvard-Kyoto) diacritic convention should be used for Sanskrit, Prakrit and Pali phonemes:
